

Next Steps Checklist

Workplace union organisation

Is there a member of your union branch leading on just transition and climate change issues?

Are these issues discussed at members / branch meetings?

Does the branch liaise with other unions on these issues?

Does the branch have any contact with community / campaign groups in the local area?

Regional union organisation

Is your union branch linked into any regional structures?

Does the union have any input in to regional policies that have a just transition and climate change impact?

National union organisation

Does your union have any policy positions on just transition and climate change?

Does your union provide any training for members and reps on just transition and climate change issues?

Does your union provide any guidance on just transition and climate change issues?

Has your union declared a climate emergency?

Raising issues with the employer

Has the employer produced a policy statement on the environment and / or climate change challenges?

Does the policy include engagement with the union(s)?

Is there a forum or committee for unions to be consulted on environment / climate change strategy?

Has the employer established targets for specific environmental / climate change issues?

Does the employer conduct environment audits / inspections?	
Does the employer measure all carbon emissions?	
Has the employer agreed a target for when it will be carbon neutral?	
Has the employer agreed the measures for how it will achieve carbon neutrality?	
Has the employer declared a climate emergency?	
Has the employer agreed a strategy that covers just transition principles on procurement and standards in any supply chains?
